Senate Energy and Water Bill Surges Oregon FY 2008 Earmarks to \$257 Million, 10 Times FY 2007 Level.

The Senate Energy and Water Bill adds a total of \$170 Million in additional Oregon earmarks. This "surge" of 59 energy and water projects pushes the total House and Senate Oregon Earmarks for FY 2008 to **\$257 Million** compared to reported FY 2007 earmarks of \$25.73M. (07 levels were calculated from Citizens against Government Waste database [here](#)). Thus, with about 2/3rds of FY 2008 appropriations bills passed, Oregon earmarks for FY 2008 are already **10 times the FY 2007 level, or an 899% increase in one year.**

SENATE: 6 Bills; Interior and Environment, Commerce and Justice, Labor and HHS, Homeland Security, Military Construction /VA, Energy and Water.

HOUSE: 2 Bills; Financial Services, Interior and Environment.
