Oregon FY 2008 Earmarks Reach \$470 Million, 18 Times FY 2007 Level, With 45% of Appropriations Bills Still to Come.

Earmarks for the HUD/Transportation bill in both the House and Senate, and the Senate State and Foreign Operations bill have been added to the Oregon FY 2008 earmarks database. With 55% of the agency appropriations bills completed, Oregon FY 2008 earmarks jumped to **\$470 Million** compared to reported FY 2007 earmarks of \$25.73M. Thus, Oregon earmarks for FY 2008 are already **18 times the FY 2007 level, or a 1727% increase in one year.** ('07 levels were calculated from Citizens against Government Waste database [here](#)).

SENATE: 8 Bills; Interior and Environment, Commerce and Justice, Labor and HHS, Homeland Security, Military Construction /VA, Energy and Water, HUD/Transportation, State and Foreign Operations.

HOUSE: 4 Bills; Financial Services, Interior and Environment, Energy and Water, HUD/Transportation.
